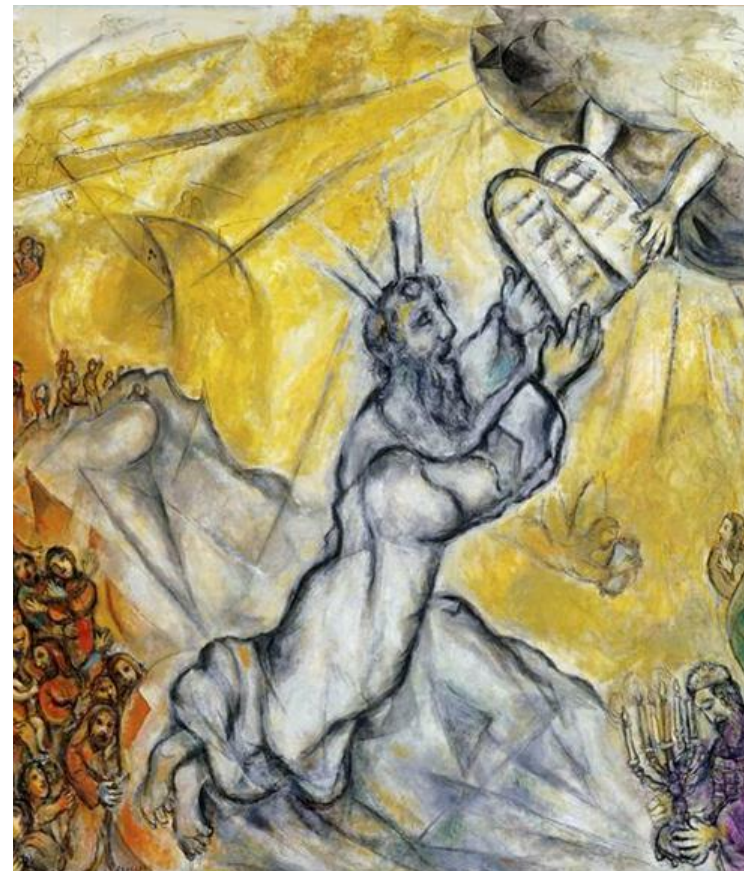

Our diocesan regulation on sabbaticals states: "At greater intervals it is important for a member of the clergy to spend more extended periods of time renewing his or her preparedness for ministry, pursuing personal development, and/or pursuing worthy, scholarly interests relative to his or her area of ministry." During his sabbatical, Fr. Paul will be going on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land as well as preparing a thesis proposal for an academic program. The sabbatical is from 1 May to 31 July.
